### President's Notes – Max Stubbs

The landscaping of the Community Centre is now underway. The plan for the landscaping was devised by Micki McCormick, Jane Cuff, and Jim Connell. The Fripp Inland Women's club has been very generous in donating time and money for the landscaping. Karen Wolbrink and Mike Ashby have been the Centre Board representatives and very involved in planning and selecting the water fountain, flower pots, and plants. The center court will have a beautiful water fountain with a background of flowering Leptospermum. The ground in the center court will have a layer of colorful rock. The planters will be spaced around the deck and chapel entrance and have a variety of deer resistant annuals and perennials. Split leaf philodendron and a colorful crape myrtle will be in the area in front of the stained glass window. The mound in front of the new addition will have a variety of split leaf philodendron. Jerry Burke has installed a sprinkler and drip irrigation system in all the areas being landscaped. We graciously thank the members of the Women's Club in making the outside of the Centre a beautiful sight for everyone to enjoy.

Electrical work has been completed in and outside the Community Centre. Spot lights were placed in the rear of the new addition to light the walkway and parking lot. Outlets were placed outside the chapel entrance to provide electricity for the water fountain. An outlet was placed in the Community Centre near the office to provide electricity for various group functions. Two outlets were placed in the chapel near the piano and choir seating area.

The Nancy Thode concert to benefit the Community Centre was held on April 19<sup>th</sup> in the chapel. Nancy is a Fripp resident and grew up in the Beaufort area, and she has a deep love of Beaufort and Fripp Island. The musical autobiography of her life was attended by over one hundred family, friends and Fripp residents. Everyone in attendance enjoyed hearing about Nancy's very interesting adventures and misadventures while growing up in Beaufort in the 1950s, and about being a young women in New York City in the 1960's. She also told and sang about living in Baltimore and Connecticut. Over \$800 was raised in donations for the Community Centre.

**The Community Centre Board passed a policy at our April Meeting to stay in compliance with S.C. law.** Our policy states that any group or individual that uses the Community Centre, and charges a fee and serves beer, wine, or liquor must first have a South Carolina permit or liquor license. The fee for a one day beer/wine license is \$10, and the fee for a beer, wine and liquor license is \$35. An application from the Department of Revenue must be filled out.

**Our Easter Sunrise Service was attended by over 400 people.** It was a beautiful morning with the sun shining out from the ocean into the Beach Club Pavilion with the cross in the background. Jerry Hammet presided, and told Barabbas' story of the Crucifixion of Christ.
